St. Johnsbury Railroad Station

Built by the Fairbanks family in 1883. In its heyday the station welcomed more than twenty passenger trains per day. The Railroad Station currently functions as St. Johnsbury's Welcome Center.



Fuller Hall

St. Johnsbury Academy's auditorium, built in 1930, is a brick Neoclassical building with massive white Tuscan columns.



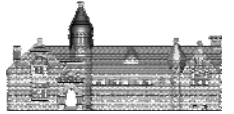
St. Johnsbury House

Originally a Main Street hostelry where many dignitaries have stayed. Currently serves as a center for seniors and a community gathering place.



The Fairbanks Museum

The museum's Richardsonian Romanesque building is the centerpiece of St. Johnsbury's historic Main Street. **While supplies last!**



North Congregational Church

The gray North Church, designed by Lambert Packard, was built in Mediaeval Gothic style from Isle La Motte limestone.



The Athenaeum

St. Johnsbury's public library and art gallery was built in the Second Empire style. It is a *National Historic Landmark*. **Available as ornament or keychain.**



Summer Street School

This historic brick schoolhouse with its distinctive bell tower served the community for more than 140 years.
