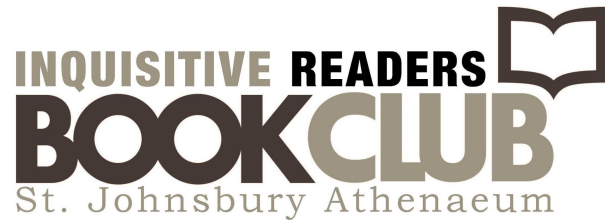

Arts & Culture Artist Reception: Tara Goreau and Her Community Art Wednesday, March 15, 7 pm

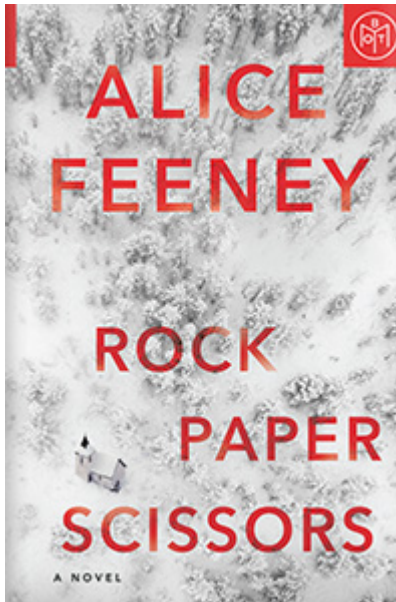
